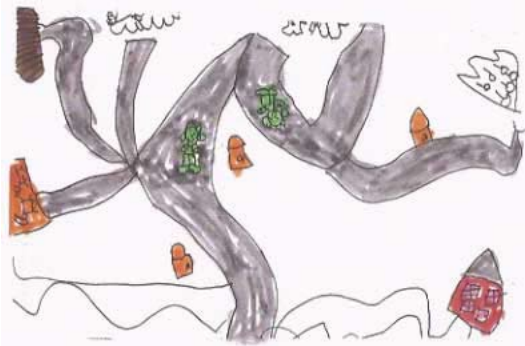


Slide Ranch

in the raindrops on the flowers.



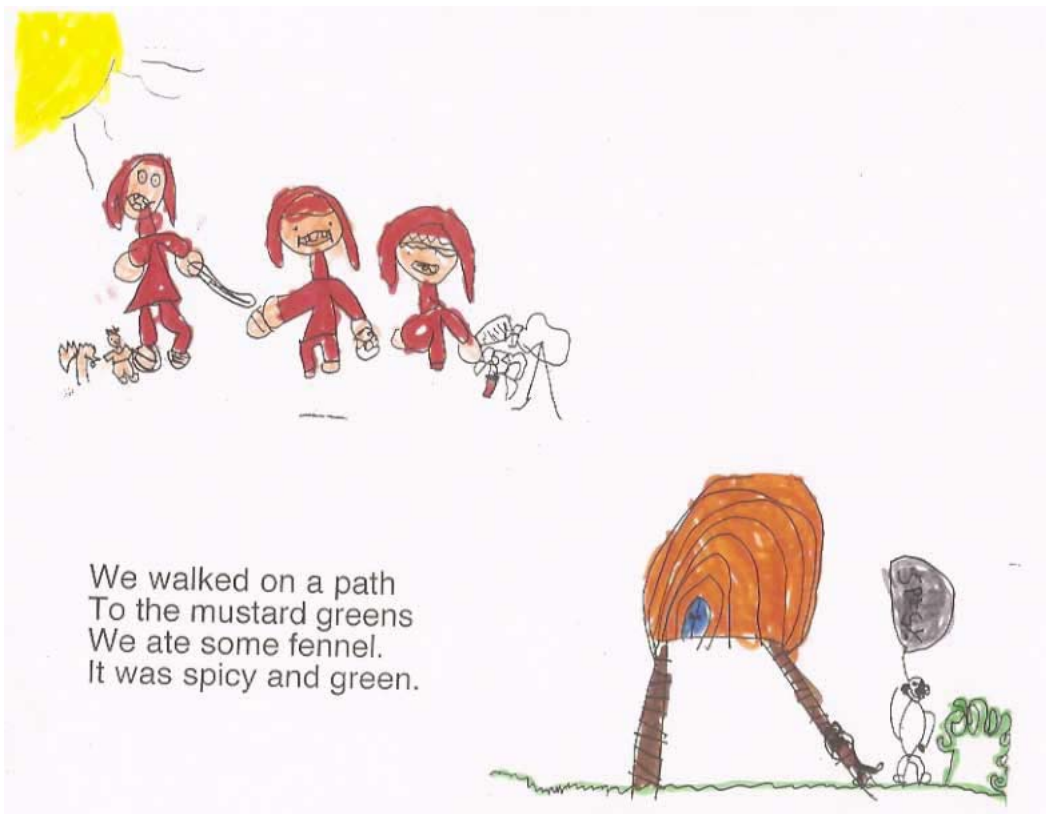
We went to the bone yard

when they fell on each other.

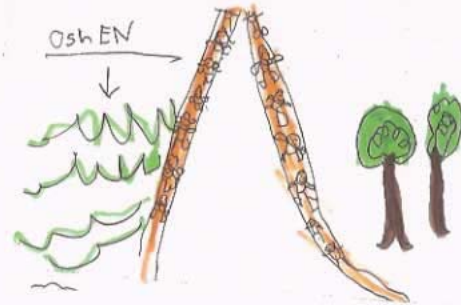




We walked on a path
